35	Approval of Minutes from June 25, 2015					
36	Tom James motioned to approve the minutes from June 25, 2015, Marla Durham					
37	seconded the motion.

39	Marla mentioned one change, as Kim Kedzierski was listed as present, but she was not					
40	actually at the meeting.

42	The motion passed unanimously with the amendment.

87 Article 6: 88 Keeley Schell suggested a change to the wording, saying that it should 89 read: 90 'The forming districts of the Union District recognize the benefits 91 to be gained from establishing district-wide curricula as well as 92 their obligation to do so, and to otherwise standardize their 93 operations on or before July 1, 2017. 94 • The committee approved of the article with the suggested language 95 change 96 Article 8: 97 Additional language was added since last meeting to address the 98 ownership of the high school 99 Chris Leopold also provided a second revised version 100 • The purpose of the revised version was to address some of the concerns 101 the committee had on how it might effect individual districts, capital 102 improvements, etc. 103 It also included a new provision related to the high school property, 104 which said that the board should have the discretion on how the 105 property would be sold and it should be treated differently than the 106 elementary buildings 107 Brian O'Regan mentioned that in the preamble it can be further 108 explained that any sale of property would require voter approval 109 • The committee approved the revised vision with the revisions 110 Article 9: 111 Chris Leopold mentioned that there are a couple different ways that this 112 could be structured and he explained the two options that the committee 113 would be looking at 114 Proportional vs. at-large 115 Marla Durham asked that if the new RED board wanted to change the 116 voting process in the future, could it? 117 Chris Leopold said yes, the new board could revisit the process in 118 the future 119 There was discussion around potentially combining the two options 120 Chris Leopold added that there would still be issues with having 121 at-large members if an advisable district voted no in terms of 122 joining 123 He also said that the committee could take article 9 at written, 124 but add additional language around how the board shall look at 125 the system again following when the next census 126 After back and forth discussion around this topic, the 127 committee approved the language as is, with a revision 128 that there would be language added that every 10 years 129 the new board would review the census information to 130 make sure that the populations are proportional and when

131		they do that, they can give consideration to moving to the
132		at-large option
133	•	Article 10:
134		 This article looked at the terms of the board members once they are
135		elected, the potential composition of school directors and when terms
136		would start/end
137		 Additional language was added since last meeting
138		 Brendan Kinney mentioned the date listed and Chris Leopold said
139		whatever date that is set in article 11 will dictate this date
140		 The committee approved the article as is
141	•	Article 11:
142		o There was discussion by the committee around the date of the vote, as it
143		needs to take place by June 30, 2016 in accordance with Act 46
144		 The committee talked about the overall timing and what would be
145		needed to schedule a revote if one was needed
146		If any of the communities votes 'no,' then turnaround time would
147		be very limited if the original vote it pushed back from November
148		to the spring
149		 Practicality wise, local town clerks have suggested that having a vote in
150		the spring isn't ideal and instead suggested the November date
151		 November 3 has been used as a potential date to hold the vote
152		 Martha Heath recommended pushing it back to November 10
153		 This would be a special election because there are no other votes taking
154		place in November this year
155		 The committee voted that November 10 would be the date of the vote,
156		to be included in articles 10 and 11
157	•	Article 12:
158		 This article was tentatively approved at a prior meeting
159		 There were some modifications made in the language since last time
160		which were suggested by the committee
161		 The committee approved the article with the modifications
162	•	Article 13:
163		 The committee approved this article previously
164	•	Article 14:
165		 There was a modification made from last meeting, giving CCSU an
166		additional month to close out its books
167		 Brian Donahue asked if one of the first jobs of the new board would be to
168		hire a new superintendent?
169		Chris Leopold said yes
170		 The committee approved the article with the modification
171	•	Article 15:
172		 Mitchell Stern had a question about the narrative and when will that be
173		written?

174			 Brian O'Regan and Brendan Kinney said that the financial
175			information that has been presented over the course of the
176			meetings would be included as part of the preamble/narrative
177			 The work of Grant Geisler and Roger George was brought
178			up and how the committee was appreciative of their
179			continued efforts
180		0	Marla Durham highlighted the fact that the preamble might be even
181			more important than the language in the articles
182		0	Brendan Kinney said that if the articles were affirmed tonight, work
183			would then began on the preamble and the committee should aim to
184			have that completed by July 20
185			 At that time, the articles and report would then be submitted to
186			the Agency of Education by August 1
187	•	Article	16:
188		0	This article looked at grade configurations
189		0	The article highlights that no school closures are planned in the
190			immediate future
191		0	There was typo in second grouping where it says 'Essex Junction High
192			School' and should be changed to 'U#46'
193		0	Also it should read that there are six elementary schools, two middle
194			schools and one high school
195		0	There was a question on if CTE should be listed?
196			 Chris Leopold said that it's part of the high school, but you could
197			list it separately here
198			 The committee agreed that it should be added to the list
199		0	The committee approved article with additional changes listed
200	•	Article	17:
201		0	There was a suggestion in the last sentence to change 'thee' to 'full
202			authority'
203		0	The committee thought the wording in the first sentence should be
204			changed from 'provided however,' to 'provided however with parental
205			consent'
206			 There was discussion on the phrasing and the use of the word
207			'parent'
208		0	The committee approved the article with the added revisions
209	•	Article	19:
210		0	There was a suggestion to add the word 'until' in the first sentence prior
211			to 'June 30, 2016'
212		0	After some discussion, Chris Leopold mentioned that under current law,
213			the state can't require a unified union be assigned to another district or
214			that districts can be assigned to a unified union
215		0	There was also a suggestion to end the first sentence with 'to reconsider
216			and join the Union District.' This would eliminate 'by voting in favor of

217	joining no later than June 30, 2017 with admission granted in advance by
218	the Union District.'
219	 The committee agreed to the language with the revisions
220	Article 20:
221	 Chris Leopold said that before the articles are submitted to the Agency of
222	Education, there has to be a name associated with the work
223	 The committee decided to form a sub-committee to work on a name
224	prior to the report being finalized
225	 The committee approved the article as written and will call it a unified
226	union district until the sub-committee makes its recommendation
227	
228	Brendan Kinney motioned to approve the articles of agreement as amended, Martha
229	Heath seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
230	
231	Marla Durham added that the minutes make this meeting official, so the
232	committee needs to approve them once they are finished
233	Brendan Kinney said that he will look at the logistics and reach out to the
234	committee to set up a time to approve the minutes once they are distributed to
235	each of the committee members

237	Martha Heath thanked Brendan Kinney for all his work, as well as Judith DeNova, Mark
238	Andrews and the staffs at CCSU and ETSD for their help and everything that they
239	provided this committee
